Temples in Utah are again open for proxy ordinances. Patrons need to schedule in advance on-line through churchofjesuschrist.org/temples. If patrons need assistance, they should contact Ward leaders or Temple and Family History Consultants. Patrons are encouraged to bring their own temple clothing, although Temple clothing is available. Maximum group size for proxy ordinances is limited, for example, for baptisms it is typically a total of 16 patrons, including those accompanying youth. Baptismal clothing is provided. We are so blessed to again have Temples open around us; some may have appointments available same day (Jordan River), while others may require more advance planning, but the websites, like the Temples, are patron friendly.
