To help you find your kindred dead, come and see our expert consultants and use our large screens. Hours are Monday through Friday 10am to 1pm, Tuesday and Thursday 1pm to 4pm, and Tuesday and Wednesday 7pm to 9pm. Our nearby FamilySearch Center is in the Monument Park Stake building, 1320 S. Wasatch Drive, lower NW corner of the building, lower level on the west side. Masks are strongly recommended.

Stake Temple Day:

Please join us for Stake Temple Day at Jordan River Temple, Thursday, November 18th, 6:40 PM Endowment Session. Individuals can make reservations for two people by scheduling on-line at churchofjesuschrist.org/temples. This will be an opportunity for Stake members to gather and strengthen spiritual foundations in preparation for Stake Conference in December.

Temple Schedule:

Temples in Utah are again open for proxy ordinances. Patrons need to schedule in advance on-line through churchofjesuschrist.org/temples. If patrons need assistance, they should contact Ward leaders or Temple and Family History Consultants. Patrons are encouraged to bring their own temple clothing, although Temple clothing is available. Maximum group size for proxy ordinances is limited, for example, for baptisms it is typically a total of 16 patrons, including those accompanying youth. Baptismal clothing is provided. We are so blessed to again have Temples open around us; some may have appointments available same day (Jordan River), while others may require more advance planning, but the websites, like the Temples, are patron friendly.

Stake Temple Recommend Interviews:

A member of the Stake Presidency is available each Sunday from 12:30 to 2:00 PM (except on Fast Sundays, Stake Conference and General Conference weekends) at the Stake Center offices. Those who are unable to meet during these times can contact Scott Hagen (#801-824-0640) who will help set up an interview with a member of the Stake Presidency.
