Things that I thought I knew about as an adolescent but actually never had an in depth conversation with him about until a few days ago. He described how he was uprooted from his house and moved into a small apartment with his Mom and 2 little brothers. He told me he remembers using shampoo branded Deseret Industries. He told me he would doctor the bishop's storehouse order to read two gallons of chocolate milk as opposed to just one. As I listened it broke my heart to think about his circumstances and how I wished I would have been a better friend during this difficult time in his life. I was also so grateful that The Church of Jesus Christ had the means and methods to care for my friend's family.

I learned a lesson after talking with him that friends' circumstances may be different than we realize. I hope that I can be a better friend to those around me and pay better attention to their situation. I hope this will inspire you to do the same.
